



NEW LOCAL RULES (Effective 1st January 2019)

1. Out of Bounds (Rule 18.2)

- Beyond any fence, wall or hedge bounding the course.
- Beyond the white stakes to the left of the 1st, 14th, 15th, 16th & 17th holes.
- In or over the trench in front of the bungalow and beyond the white stakes to the left of the 18th hole.
- On or over the path (defined by the wooden edge) surrounding the Clubhouse up to the white line on the same path adjacent to the 1st Tee.

2. Penalty Areas (Rule 17)

- Red & yellow stakes define the margin of the penalty areas.
- The red penalty areas to the left of the 14th & 16th holes extend to and coincide with the out of bounds edge.

3. Immovable Obstructions Close to the Putting Green (Fixed Sprinkler Heads)

- Immovable obstructions close to putting green: In addition to the types of interference described in Rule 16.1a, when a ball lies in the general area, interference also exists if an immovable obstruction is: on the player's line of play, is within two club-lengths of the putting green, and is within two club-lengths of the ball. The player may take relief under Rule 16.1b. (*Exception – There is no relief under this Local Rule if the player chooses a line of play that is clearly unreasonable.*)

4. Relief from Tree Roots in Fairway

- If a player's ball in the general area has interference from tree roots in the fairway or in the rough within 2 club-lengths of the fairway, free relief is available under Rule 16.1b. But interference does not exist if the tree roots only interfere with the player's stance.

5. Relief from Aeration Holes

- If a player's ball lies in or touches an aeration hole:
 - (a) Ball in General Area. The player may take relief under Rule 16.1b. If the ball comes to rest in another aeration hole the player may take relief again under this Local Rule.
 - (b) Ball on Putting Green. The player may take relief under Rule 16.1d.**But** interference does not exist if the aeration hole only interferes with the player's stance or, on the putting green, on the player's line of play.
